



Post-Operative Sedation Instructions

The following instructions are important after your sedation appointment.

1. Patient should not drive for 24 hours after the sedation appointment.
2. Patient should not operate any hazardous devices for 24 hours.
3. A responsible person should be with the sedation patient until he/she has fully recovered.
4. Patient should not climb up or down stairs unattended. The patient should stay on the ground floor until he/she has fully recovered.
5. Patient has no eating limitations. He/She may eat whenever and whatever he/she would like.
6. Patient should drink plenty of fluids as soon as possible.
7. Patient may sleep for a long period of time or may be alert when he/she leaves our office. The responsible person should not leave the sedation patient alone at any state.
8. Always hold the sedation patient's arm while walking.
9. If the sedation patient feels that his/her symptoms warrant the attention of a physician and are unable to reach our office, the patient should go to the nearest emergency room immediately.
10. Patient should not carry, sleep next to or be left alone with the elderly or young children for 24 hours after the last dosage of medication.
